
Fall Workshop Update Next Level SEM | October 19 | Portland, OR

SEM Project Spotlight Multifamily SEM Finds Cost-Saving Opportunities in Affordable Housing

In April 2022, Energy Trust of Oregon launched a Multifamily SEM offer across 12 affordable housing properties in Southern Oregon and the Portland metro area.
